Free	15	Easy	We will be celebrating the first Scottish settlers who arrived on the ship Hector in 1773 by walking from the Historic Log Church (1576 Loch Broom Rd, Pictou County) to the Ship Hector on the Pictou Waterfront. The full 15-km walk will start at the Historic Log Church at 10:00 am. Participants may choose to walk the full 15 km distance to Pictou or join at one of the other locations along the way as we pass through and continue from there. There are two other starting points, the first at the Scotch Hill Rd/Jitney Trail intersection (8km to Pictou) and the second at Brown's Point (3km to Pictou). We will arrive in Pictou in time to join the Tattoo festivities at 2:00 pm. Join us for the entire walk or any portion and be part of the 250th celebration of the arrival of Ship Hector!
