The causeways and bridges across the SMT are exposed to the elements more so than the wood approaches. Be prepared for the weather and bring water & snacks. This is a good easy walk for all ages. The Shearwater Aviation Museum is at the far end of the trail, we may be able to arrange a tour for our hikers. The Shearwater Air Force Base is celebrating 100 years this summer. You can see planes being restored and celebrate some aviation history. Admission is free. The hike is an easy one for all ages. Heritage and other Park Trails <i>Cole Harbour</i>	November 4 12:00 PM	No	Free	6	Moderate	Travelling along the Hwy 207 (AKA the Cole Harbour Rd) turn onto Hwy 322 (AKA Bissett Rd) and then turn into the parking lot at 256 Bissett Rd where the two red buildings are located on the left. This should be a great fall hike through hilly woodland forest. Please dress for the weather. While the Heritage Trail is relatively flat, wide and easy, the inner park trails travel up and down drumlins, which can be steep.
