Baxter's Harbour Waterfall Tour Baxter's Harbour	November 10 11:30 AM	Yes director@canningr ecreation.com	Free	7	Moderate	Meet at the corner of Old Baxter Mill Rd and Black Hole Rd, 1 to 2 kms east of Baxters Harbour (follow the paved Baxters Harbour Rd down to its end at a T-turn right onto a dirt road and drive for a km or so). The hiking route has changed to included visiting three waterfalls over sometimes rocky terrain, and will NOT require any major stream crossings (any crossings will be optional, and at hikers' discretion). After heavy rain on Fri/Sat, the paths will likely be wet, but the falls will be flowing well. Please bring minimum 1 L water, energy snacks/lunch, comfortable hiking footwear (and extra socks), small knapsack for carrying your supplies, dress in layers (synthetic or wool fabrics are best; keep cotton to a minimum), gloves/hat if necessary. Be prepared for a chilly Fundy breeze. The route is less than 6 km round-trip (2-3 hrs), much of it on road, but the terrain is rugged near the falls.
